IRWA Course Manuals are now in a spiral-bound format [Figure 1]. The paperback structure of the previous course manual design made writing in the manuals difficult. Participants struggled when exercises required writing in the manuals; this not an issue with th new manuals [Figure 2].

Spiral binding allows for greater efficiency in the classroom. The new manuals utilize double-sided, allowing for less paper to be used.

Participant manuals will also have new appendices which include answers to exercises and case studies, for participant reference after a class has concluded.

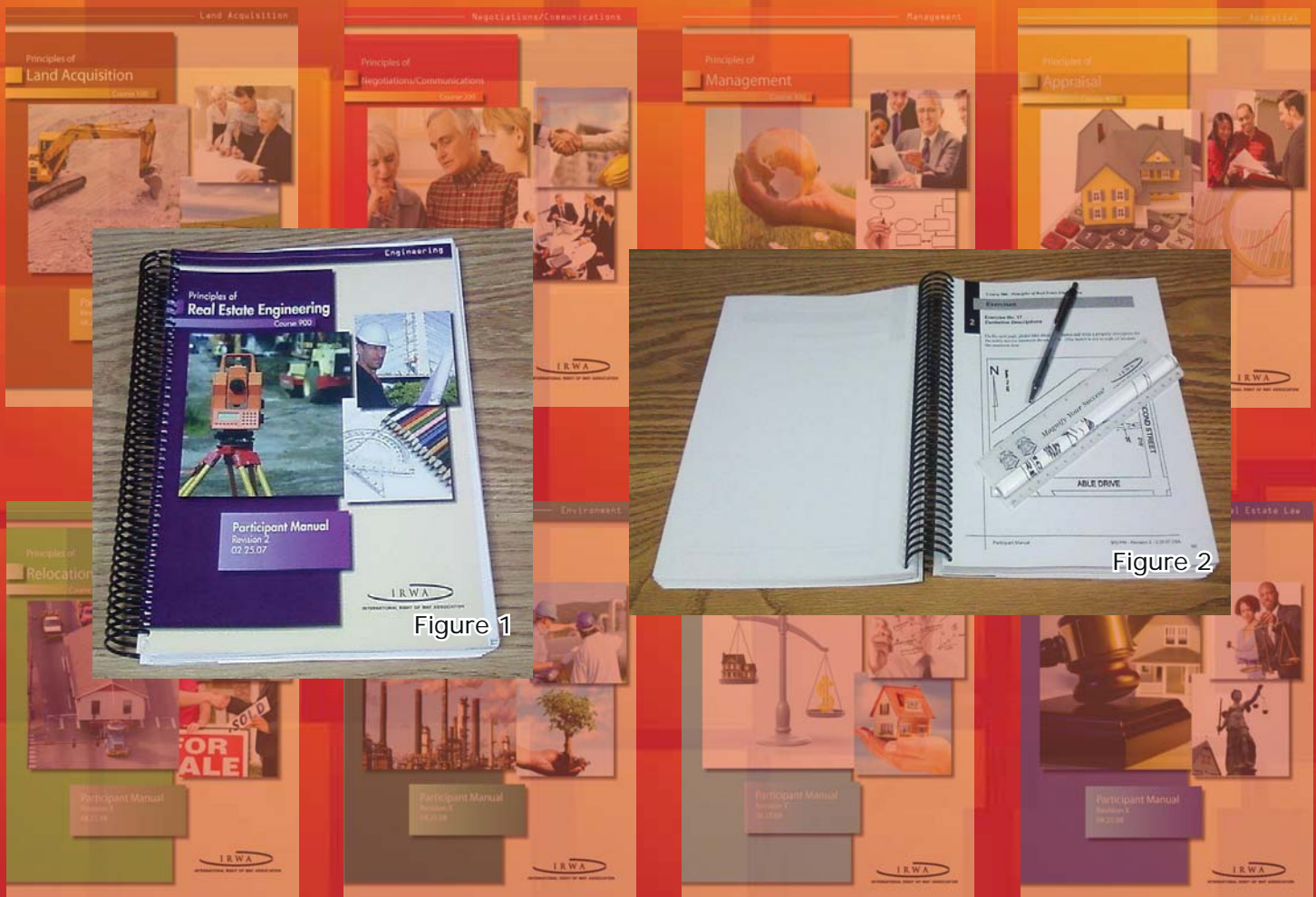
