Do you know when you need to recertify?



SR/WA and Certified members can look up their recertification due date online by checking their records through the “My Information” section of the IRWA website.

What you need to know about taking your SR/WA Exam prior to candidacy

For those who have attended the SR/WA Comprehensive Review class and taken the Comprehensive Exam without prior candidacy approval, you must submit your candidacy application within 30 days from the date the exam was taken or your exam results will be null and void. You will then need to re-take the exam after your candidacy is approved.



Did you know... your SR/WA Exam may count towards certification program requirements?



If you successfully passed the individual SR/WA exams for Relocation and/or Valuation you have fulfilled the exam requirement for that discipline’s certification. However, the SR/WA Comprehensive Exam will not fulfill the certification exam requirements.

Using Chapter/Region and Non-IRWA programs for recertification credit:

If you want to use attendance at Chapter or Region events or even Non-IRWA seminars or courses, for recertification credit you must submit a request for approval prior to sending in your recertification paperwork. Application for Award of credit for non-IRWA must be completed and submitted to my attention along with the required supporting documents. IRWA launching new online course format: Changes to 103WBT and 215CBT format:



As of July 1, 2008, courses 103WBT (the ethics course) and 215CBT (the Right of Way Agent's Development course) will no longer be offered in their current format. IRWA is in the process of transferring these courses to a totally new format.

The change in format will have no effect on the course requirement for the designation and certification programs. Both courses will still apply for initial designation and certification as well as recertification for the SR/WA and all R/W programs.
