Grade Point Average (based on 9-1/4's /6 Semesters or 3 years accumulative GPA) (20 Points)

- 1) Minimum of 3.0 GPA, 75% or B+ to qualify.
- 2) GPA shall consist of the most recent three (3) Years.

The following items should be included with this application (20 points)

- 1) Transcript for the Last three (3) years of studies.
- 2) A letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor or guidance counselor.
- 3) A letter of recommendation from an employer or professional associate.
If you have not had significant employment, the letter may be from a community leader or clergyman with whom you are personally acquainted.
- 4) Non-related person reference(i.e. community leader, cleryman, etc.)
- 5) Provide a brief bio of yourself.
